

Firearm Safety & Range Rules

The safety of our customers and staff is our top priority

1. Always Keep Firearms Pointed In A Safe Direction.
2. Always Keep Your Finger Off The Trigger And Out Of The Trigger Guard Until Ready To Fire.
3. Always Keep The Firearm Unloaded With The Action Open And Magazine Removed Until Positioned In A Shooting Booth and Ready To Fire.
4. Never Handle Firearms Behind The Firing Line.
5. All Firearms That Are Not Holstered Must Be Cased In An Unloaded Condition While Going To And From The Range.
6. Loaded Firearms May Only Be Holstered Or Un-holstered While Positioned In A Shooting Booth And Pointed In A Safe Direction.
7. Be Sure The Firearm Is Safe To Operate. The Range Officer May, At His/Her Sole Discretion, Declare A Firearm Unsafe For Use On The Shooting Range.
8. Eye and Ear Protection Is Mandatory To Enter, And At All Times While On, The Shooting Range. Caution: Prescription Glasses Or Sunglasses May Not Provide An Adequate Level Of Eye Protection.
9. No One Is Permitted Beyond The Firing Line For Any Reason!
10. Please Remain In Assigned Shooting Lane. Report Any Equipment Malfunction To The Range Officer.
11. There Is A Maximum Of 3 People Per Shooting Lane. Un-Cased Firearms Must Remain In The Booth When Switching Shooters.
12. You Are Responsible For Every Round You Fire And Are Liable For Any Damage Caused By Shooting The Floor, Walls, Ceiling, Range Equipment Or In Any Other Unsafe Direction!
13. Do Not Shoot At Targets Closer Than 18 Feet.
14. Do Not Shoot At Targets On The Floor Or That Have Fallen From The Target Carrier!
15. Only Paper Or Cardboard Targets May Be Hung From Target Carriers. No Other Objects Are Permitted To Be Hung From Targets Or Carriers.
16. Never Use Alcohol Or Drugs Before Or While Shooting.

17. No Food, Drink, Gum Or Tobacco is Permitted Inside The Range. Wash Your Hands Each Time You Leave The Range And Before Smoking, Eating Or Drinking.
18. Shooters Who Desire To Shoot From The Holster With A Handgun Must Be "Holster Qualified" Through MWGC Range Officers And Pay An Annual Fee Of \$15.
19. Anyone Under 18 Must Be Accompanied By A Parent Or Guardian. Note: Parents And Guardians Are Responsible For Ensuring Range Rules Are Followed And Are Accountable For Any Damage Caused By A Minor.
20. Act Responsibly At All Times
21. If You Observe An Unsafe Condition, Report It To The Range Officer Immediately!
22. Anyone Creating An Unsafe Condition May, At The Sole Discretion Of The Range Officer, Be Directed to Immediately Leave The Range And Possibly Forfeit All Privileges To Use The Shooting Range In The future.
23. **The Following Firearms Are Prohibited:**
 - ✓ Any Firearm Chambered In A Centerfire Rifle Cartridge
 - ✓ NFA Firearms, Including Short-Barreled Shotguns And Full-Auto Firearms, Unless Owner Has Legal License To Have Such Firearm (i.e. Law enforcement).
 - ✓ Muzzleloaders And Flintlocks
 - ✓ Any Firearm The Range Officer Deems Unsafe.
24. **The Following Ammunition Is Prohibited:**
 - ✓ All Centerfire Rifle Calibers
 - ✓ Tracer And/Or Any Type Of Incendiary Round (Including Flares)
 - ✓ Armor Piercing And/Or Steel Core
 - ✓ Steel Shot, Steel Slugs And/Or Shotgun Sabots (Lead Shot And Low Velocity Lead Slugs Are Permitted)
 - ✓ Handgun 454 And 500 Calibers May Be Fired In Limited Amounts
 - ✓ Any Factory, Imported Or Hand Loaded Ammunition The Range Officer Deems Unsafe.
